

Information on temporary stopping places in Great Asby supplied by Great Asby Parish Council

Great Asby has a long-standing tradition of accepting visitors in the village on their way to, and during, the Fair. Great Asby Parish Council have stated significant problems have arisen in the last few years from some visitors arriving much too early, and from a minority engaging in wholly unacceptable behaviour. Accordingly, although the village greens will again be available, there are limits set as regards the areas and dates of use which must be adhered to.

Some areas of the village greens are not available for caravans or other vehicles, or for tents etc. However, these areas are still available for horse grazing. Please refer to the attached map for further information.


Please do not arrive early, ideally the Parish Council would like a minimal period of use, facilities will not be available before **Saturday 4 June 2022**. Toilets, a stand pipe and rubbish collection will be provided.

Please respect the facilities provided and the land provided by the village. During the past year the people of the village have completed a tree planting scheme along the beckside down the length of the village . Please respect this and do not tether horses or ponies to the tree guards or damage them in any other way . Please note that this land is privately owned and you do not have a legal right to be on this land.

Failure to behave responsibly and to respect others property may lead to a further review of the arrangements, with the possibility that this land will be totally unavailable in the future.

Children's' Play area – This area must be respected. No horses may be placed in the area at any time.
